



## Vendor Code of Conduct

Thank you for being a vendor at the Baden Corn Festival! To make this family friendly event a positive experience for all, there are a few vendor rules that must be adhered to. **Failure to follow these guidelines at the discretion of the Baden Corn Festival Committee will result in immediate closure of your booth with no refund. This signed form must be mailed in with your application.**

1. We promote family orientated goods. No knives, lighters, articles with offensive content (profanity, nudity, racism, etc.), body piercing services, drug paraphernalia, etc. are to be displayed or sold at the Baden Corn Festival. If there are any questions regarding particular items, contact the Corn Festival Vendor Committee at [vendors@badecornfest.ca](mailto:vendors@badecornfest.ca).
2. Only items listed in the Vendor Application are to be sold.
3. Vendor signage is allowed only in the allotted booth space. Advertising (lawn signs, banners, etc.) is forbidden outside of your booth area.
4. All activity at the vendor booth must be legal and follow all applicable health and government laws and regulations. No counterfeit or unauthorized merchandise is to be sold.
5. Booths are expected to be open for the entire duration of the festival (10:00 am to 5:00 pm). No setup or deliveries are permitted during festival time.
6. One parking spot is provided per booth; additional spots are available with advance payment of the fee. Parking is available from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm on the day of the event. Vehicles that are not part of a vending booth are to be moved before the festival opens at 10:00 am.
7. All equipment/extension cords must meet the approval of the Electrical Safety Authority. All booths requiring electricity are subject to an inspection by the Electrical Safety Authority. Direct entries into electrical boxes are not allowed. The Baden Corn Festival does not supply extension cords. Generators are allowed for emergency measures only and/or at the discretion of the Baden Corn Festival. See "Vendor Information, Terms and Conditions" for more information.
8. Booths using propane must meet the requirements of the Ministry of Consumer and Commercial Relations. Pursuant to all applications, all booths must have an approved fire extinguisher. (see "Propane Acknowledgement")
9. Booth maintenance and site clean---up are the responsibility of the leasing vendor. For those using charcoal, please bring proper containers to dispose of hot coals. Financial penalties will be assessed by the Baden Corn Festival for non---compliance.

10. All booths must meet the criteria or standards of the Region of Waterloo Public Health, Township of Wilmot Fire Department, Electrical Safety Authority and Waterloo Regional Police.
11. The Vendor shall indemnify and save harmless Baden Corn Festival and/or Baden Community Association, their employees, volunteers, agents, the property owners and management, etc. from all claims for the loss, damage, or injury to persons or property caused to the vendor, his/her employees, or agents through any wrongful act, neglect, or default. Baden Corn Festival and Baden Community Association, their employees, volunteers, agents, the property owners, management, etc., shall not be liable to the Vendor, his/her employees, agents or customers for any personal injury or damage to property. Everything brought to the premises by the Vendor, his employees and agents or customers, shall be entirely at the risk of the Vendor or others for any loss or damage in accordance with Canadian Insurance Laws. The vendor shall be responsible for the insurance of his/her own property.

**Baden Corn Festival Propane Acknowledgement**

I, [Click or tap here to enter text.](#) (vendor) do hereby agree and confirm that:

1. My workers, and I as applicant, are trained and knowledgeable in the operation of the propane tanks and that the equipment meets the requirements of the applicable legislation.
2. Cooking equipment: one (1) 3A 10BC extinguisher is required for trailers and booths, plus an extra extinguisher for outside/exterior cooking.
3. All other vendor type booths utilizing propane will require one (1) 3A 10BC extinguisher.
4. Propane shall be located not less than ten (10) feet from any ignition source.
5. Propane cylinders must be secured and protected from mechanical damage or impact.
6. Non-combustible hoods must cover deep fryers from splattering grease in the event of rain.
7. All appliances must be CSA and ULC approved.
8. All propane equipment to be installed by a Certified Gas Technician.
